STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section seven of chapter four of
the Revised Statutes, relating to Elections.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section seven of chapter four of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words "of the previous year" in the eighth line,
4 and inserting in place thereof, the words 'used at
5 the previous State election', so that said section
6 when amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 7. In all towns, cities not included, having
8 one thousand or more registered voters, the muni-
9 cipal officers shall receive applications of persons
10 claiming a right to vote, on the three secular
11 days next preceding the day of election, and no

12 application shall be received after the hour of five
13 in the afternoon on the secular day next preceding
14 said day of election; and no names shall be added
15 to the list of voters on the day of election, by cer-
16 tificate or otherwise, except such as were upon the
17 list used at the previous State election, and have
18 been inadvertently omitted by the selectmen; and
19 on that day no change shall be made in names, ex-
20 cept to correct clerical errors therein.' .
