STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize Gershom F. Burgess to build and maintain bridge across Goose River, at Rockport, in the town of Camden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. Gershom F. Burgess of Camden, his

- 2 heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and em-
- 3 powered to build and maintain at the head of navi-
- 4 gation in Rockport harbor, in said Camden, a bridge
- 5 twenty feet wide and extending thirty feet across
- 6 Goose river upon his own land, just south of the
- 7 iron bridge across said river; provided, said bridge
- 8 is so constructed as not to interfere or obstruct
- 9 navigation.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved by the governor.
