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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor Copying the Muster-Out Rolls.

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*Resolved,* That the Adjutant General be, and  
2 is hereby authorized to contract for the copying  
3 of the muster-out rolls of the Maine troops which  
4 served in the war of the rebellion, at a sum not  
5 exceeding twelve hundred dollars, six hundred to  
6 be taken from the military appropriation for the  
7 year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, and the  
8 same sum from the same appropriation for the  
9 year eighteen hundred and eighty-six.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Military Committee after a careful examination of the muster-out rolls, find that there are some four hundred or more of these rolls in the Adjutant General's Office, which, after constant use for twenty years are now in a very bad condition, many of them falling to pieces. It is absolutely necessary that some action should be taken, and that immediately, to preserve these valuable papers. The rolls are in constant use daily and should be copied and the original laid by. As the years roll by these records become more valuable to the State and to the soldier. The State has only one set of these rolls.
