STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section seventy of chapter six of
the Revised Statutes, relating to Assessments of
Taxes in places not incorporated.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section seventy of chapter six of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking
3 out from the third line of said section, the words,
4 "including those made on account of highways,"
5 so that said section, as amended, shall read as
6 follows:

'SECT. 70. Such lands may be assessed by the
8 county commissioners according to the last State
9 valuation for a due proportion of county taxes.

10 Lists of such taxes shall immediately be certified
11 and transmitted by the county treasurer to the
12 Treasurer of State. In the list, each such town-
13 ship and tract shall be sufficiently described, with
14 the date and amount of assessment on each. The
15 Treasurer of State shall, in his books, credit the
16 county treasurer for the amount of each such
17 assessment; and when paid to him, shall certify to
18 the county treasurer the amount of tax and inter-
19 est so paid, on the first Monday of each Jan-
20 uary.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
