STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to provide for Recording Deeds made by
the State of Maine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled as follows:*

Any person interested in any land conveyed by
2 the State of Maine, the deed of which is recorded
3 in the Land Agent's office, may cause a copy,
4 attested by the Land Agent, to be filed and
5 recorded in the registry of deeds in the county
6 and registry district where said land lies, whether
7 said deed shall or not have been acknowledged by
8 the Agent or other person making the same; and
9 such record shall have all the force and effect of
10 a record of deeds duly acknowledged.
