## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section seventy of chapter seventyseven of the Revised Statutes relating to writs and processes of superior courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section seventy of chapter seventy-seven 2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by 3 striking out the words "of said justices," in the 4 first line, and inserting in place thereof the words 5 'justices of a superior court.' Also by striking 6 out the words "either of said superior courts," in 7 the second line, and inserting in place thereof the 8 words 'any superior court.' And by adding to

9 said section the words 'and may be made returna-10 ble in the superior court of any other county in11 which the action might be legally brought.' So12 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 70. Each justice of a superior court shall 14 establish a seal for his said court; all writs and 15 processes issuing from any superior court shall 16 be in the name of the State, of the usual forms, 17 bearing the teste of the justice thereof, under the 18 seal of said court; they shall be signed by its clerk 19 and obeyed and executed throughout the State and 20 may be made returnable in the superior court of 21 any other county in which the action might be 22 legally brought.'
