STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the Judge and Register
of Probate for Hancock County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. From and after the first day of Jan-
2 uary in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
3 hundred and eighty-seven the salary of the judge
4 of probate for Hancock County shall be five hun-
5 dred dollars a year.

SECT. 2. From and after the first day of January
2 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
3 and eighty-seven the salary of the register of pro-
4 bate for Hancock County shall be five hundred
5 dollars a year.

SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.

Amended in the committee consisting of Hancock Co. Delegation by striking out the word "six," in the fifth line of Sec. 1, in the written bill, and inserting in the place thereof the word 'five.'

Also by striking out the word "six," in the fifth line of Sec. 2 of the written bill and inserting in the place thereof the word 'five.'
