Resolved, That the Land Agent is hereby author-

- 2 ized to convey to Henry H. Goss lot number forty-
- 3 five in township number thirteen, range six, Aroos-
- 4 took County, waiving further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

A land certificate was issued to Henry H. Goss, in 1878, of lot No. 45 in Portage Lake Plantation (T. No. 13, R. 6). Mr. Goss has paid the road labor, and cleared the requisite amount of land, and performed all settling duties except building. The lot is not a good settling lot, and Mr. Goss lives on an adjoining lot. This lot is not suitable for a farm, and has been burned over, thus destroying the timber.
