STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relative to election of Selectmen, Assessors and Overseers of the Poor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. At the annual town meetings to be 2 held in March, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, 3 the voters shall choose by a major vote, by ballot, 4 three inhabitants of the town to be selectmen, 5 assessors and overseers of the poor, one of whom 6 shall be elected for three years, one for two years, 7 and one for one year; and thereafter, except to fill 8 any vacancy, one selectman, assessor and overseer

9 of the poor shall be so elected annually for three 10 years.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent 2 with this Act hereby repealed.
