## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize Henry H. Page to navigate the Lower Lakes on the West Branch of Penobscot River by steam.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Henry H. Page his associates and

- 2 assigns are hereby vested with the exclusive right
- 3 of employing and navigating every kind of boat
- 4 or water craft propelled by steam for him or as
- 5 common carrier on the Lower Lakes of the West
- 6 Branch of Penobscot River, to wit: Pamadumcook
- 7 North Twin, South Twin and Ambejijus lakes, all

- 8 connected and situated in Penobscot and Aroos-
- 9 took counties with full power to construct locks,
- 10 piers and wharves for the term of twenty years
- 11 from the approval of this act.
  - Sect. 2. A reasonable toll is hereby authorized
  - 2 for transportation of persons and merchandise and
  - 3 for towing logs on and across said lakes, the rates
  - 4 to be established by the County Commissioners of
  - 5 Penobscot County from time to time as they may
  - 6 determine.
  - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

To the Honorable House and Senate of Maine in Legislature assembled.

The undersigned respectfully prays your honorable bodies to grant a charter to him and his assigns with exclusive rights for twenty years, to navigate by steam the Lower Lakes, so called, on the West Branch of Penobscot River, to wit: Pamadumcook, North Twin, South Twin and Ambejijus lakes, with the right to construct locks and wharves for the accommodation of steam yessels.
