IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the St. John Boundary Branch Dam Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. W. B. Rice, Alonzo Lane, James
2 Pierce and William H. Maling, their associates and
3 assigns, are hereby created a corporate body by the
4 name of the St. John Boundary Branch Dam Com-
5 pany with all the rights and privileges of similar
6 corporations.

SECT. 2. Said company may erect and maintain
2 a dam on the South West Branch of the Saint John
3 River in Township No. 6, R. 19., W. E. L. S., or
4 in Township No. 7, R. 19, W. E. L. S., for the

5 purpose of raising a head of water to drive logs
6 and other lumber.

SECT. 3. Said company may demand and receive
2 a reasonable toll for said logs and lumber, the same
3 to be determined and fixed from time to time by
4 the County Commissioners of Somerset County, on
5 all logs and lumber passing through said dam or
6 benefitted thereby. And said company shall have
7 a lien on all said logs and lumber on which toll is
8 assessed, but the logs or lumber of each particular
9 mark shall only be holden to pay the toll of said
10 mark, and if said toll is not paid within twenty
11 days of the time said logs or lumber or a major
12 part thereof shall arrive at its place of destination,
13 said company may sell at public auction after ten
14 days notice to the owners of said logs or lumber
15 or to the owners of the land from which the same
16 was cut.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
