STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT for the Protection of the Alewive Fishery on the Damariscotta River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Whoever shall construct, set, main-

- 2 tain or use any net, weir, seine, or other machine or
- 3 device, in the waters of the Damariscotta River
- 4 northerly of a line drawn east and west across
- 5 said river at a point one-half mile south of "Goose
- 6 Rock", so-called, for the purpose of taking or
- 7 catching alewives, or whoever shall take or catch
- 8 any alewives within said limits, except by hook and

9 line, shall be punished by a fine of twenty dollars 10 for each offence; all nets, weirs, seines or other 11 machine or device prohibited as aforesaid shall be 12 deemed forfeit and contraband, and any member 13 of the Fish Committee of the towns of Newcastle 14 and Nobleboro' finding them in such use may de-15 stroy them.

- SECT. 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed 2 to abridge or affect in any manner the rights and 3 privileges now held by law by said towns of New-4 castle and Nobleboro' in the alewive fishery in said
- Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent 2 with this act are hereby repealed.
