IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to Habeas Corpus.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter ninety-nine 2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended so as 3 read as follows:
- 'SECT. 7. When awarded by a justice of the 5 supreme judicial court, it may issue, under his hand 6 and seal, or upon his order, from any clerk's office 7 in vacation, as if issued by the court, and run 8 throughout the State, and may be returnable before 9 the court, or before himself, or any other justice

- 10 thereof, and shall be entered upon the docket of
- 11 the court in the county where returnable, and the
- 12 judgment shall there be recorded by the clerk.
- 13 When awarded by a judge of a superior court, it
- 14 may issue, and shall be entered and the judgment
- 15 recorded in like manner.'
 - Sect. 2. Section eight of said chapter is hereby
 - 2 amended by adding the following words: 'unless
 - 3 from examination of whole case the court or justice
 - 4 is of opinion that it ought to issue.'
