STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize James H. Oak to erect and maintain Piers and Booms in the Aroostook River, in the town of Presque Isle, in said Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. James H. Oak, his associates, suc-

- 2 cessors and assigns, are hereby authorized and
- 3 empowered to locate, build and maintain in the
- 4 Aroostook River, in the town of Presque Isle in
- 5 Aroostook County, between the northerly and
- 6 southerly shores of said river, northerly and oppo-
- 7 site lots numbered four, five and six in block

8 numbered four, and lots numbered one, two and 9 three in block numbered five, and lot numbered six 10 in block numbered eleven, situate in that part of 11 said town of Presque Isle which was formerly the 12 town of Maysville in said Aroostook County, piers 13 and booms for the purpose of sorting and holding 14 all logs and lumber driven down said river intended 15 for use or manufacture in mills situate within said 16 Aroostook County, or to be shipped or exported 17 by rail or otherwise.

SECT. 2. The parties named in the first section 2 of this act, their associates, successors and assigns, 3 for the erection and maintenance of said piers and 4 booms, and for connecting the same with the shores, 5 may with their agents, servants and teams, pass 6 and repass over said shores, and to and from the 7 same.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of Maine, in Legislature assembled:

The undersigned citizen of Presque Isle in Aroostook County, respectfully and earnestly prays that your honorable body will permit, authorize and empower the undersigned, James H. Oak, his associates, successors and assigns, to locate, build and maintain in the Aroostook River in said town of Presque Isle between the northerly and southerly shores of said river, northerly and opposite lots numbered four, five and six in block numbered four, and lots numbered one, two and three in block numbered five, and lot numbered six in block numbered eleven, situate in that part of Presque Isle which was formerly the town of Maysville in said Aroostook County, piers and booms for the purpose of sorting and holding all logs and lumber diven down said Aroostook River intended for use or manufacture in mills situate within said Aroostook County, or to be shipped or exported by rail or otherwise.
