EDUCATIONAL DEPARTMENT, AUGUSTA, February 2, 1887.

In the matter of the application of the town of New Sharon for the reimbursement of school money of which said town was deprived by a clerical error, the undersigned would state that in transferring from the return of the school officers of said town to the books of the Treasurer of State, the number of scholars in said town reported as 349, was written 249, so that in the apportionment of State school funds the town of New Sharon was deprived of one hundred and fifty-nine (\$159) dollars justly its due.
