STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED. AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and sixty-four of Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five, establishing the Standard Weight of a bushel of Beans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred
2 and sixty-four of the Public Laws of eighteen
3 hundred and eighty-five is hereby amended by
4 striking out the word "sixty," in the second line
5 thereof, and inserting in its place the word 'sixty-
6 two,' so that said section as amended shall read as
7 follows: 'The standard weight of a bushel of

8 beans in good order and fit for shipping is sixty-
9 two pounds.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
