STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section forty-six, chapter thirtyeight of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Measure of Milk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section forty-six of chapter thirty-2 eight, Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by 3 striking out the words "ale and beer," in said sec-4 tion, and inserting instead thereof the word 5 'wine,' so that said section, when amended, shall 6 read as follows:

SECT. 2. 'All measures, cans, or other vessels 2 used in the sale of milk, shall annually be sealed

3 by the sealer of weights and measures by wine
4 measure, and shall be marked by the sealer, with
5 figures indicating the quantity which they hold,
6 and whoever fraudulently sells by any other meas7 ure, can or vessel forfeits twenty dollars for each
8 offence.
