IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to create a Lien on Last Blocks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whoever labors in the manufacturing of last

- 2 blocks or cuts, or furnishes wood for the manu-
- 3 facture of the same, or is engaged in cooking for
- 4 persons engaged in such labor or furnishes a team
- 5 for the hauling of said last blocks or the lumber
- 6 from which they are manufactured, has a lien on
- 7 said last blocks for the amount due him for his
- 8 personal labor thereon, or that of his team and for
- 9 the amount due for wood so cut or furnished, which
- 10 takes precedence of all other claims except liens

- 11 reserved to the State; said lien shall continue for
- 12 thirty days after the said last blocks are stored or
- 13 housed for drying purposes, and shall be enforced
- 14 by attachment.
