STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of William R. Ramsdell.

Resolved, That the land agent be and hereby is
2 authorized to convey to William R. Ramsdell lot
3 No. Five (5), in Castle Hill, Aroostook County,
4 when the road labor is paid, waving further settling
5 duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

William R. Ramsdell had a land certificate of this lot in 1864. The road now travelled across this plantation does not cross this lot or pass near it. There is a very high ridge of land between said lot and the road, so that the hay cut on it is hauled away in the winter on the ice. There are about twenty acres cleared on it and a barn built, but it is not located favorably for occupation.
