RESOLVE in aid of the Children's Home in Bangor.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars
2 be and is hereby appropriated for the Children's
3 Home of Bangor, for the year 1887, and one
4 thousand dollars for the year 1888.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Children's Home, at Bangor, has always received children from other towns in the State, and for years past over one-half the number were children of soldiers from all the eastern part of the State. Last year there were children from nineteen different towns; so it is not a local or Bangor institution.

For twenty years past, more or less, the State has given \$1000 each year.
