STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to prevent persons from unlawfully using or wearing the badge of the Grand Army of the Republic of this State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any person who shall wilfully wear the badge of

- 2 the Grand Army of the Republic, or who shall use
- 3 or wear the same to obtain aid or assistance there-
- 4 by within this State, unless he shall be entitled to
- 5 use or wear the same under the Rules and Regula-
- 6 tions of the Department of Maine Grand Army of
- 7 the Republic, shall be guilty of misdemeanor, and
- 8 upon conviction shall be punished by imprisonment
- 9 for a term not to exceed thirty days in the county

10 jail, or a fine not to exceed twenty dollars, or by 11 both such fine and imprisonment.
