STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of rebuilding bridges in Cyr Plantation.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropri-

- 2 ated the sum of one hundred dollars to be expended
- 3 under the direction of an agent to be appointed by
- 4 the Governor and Council in rebuilding the bridge
- 5 across Hammond Brook (so called.) Also the
- 6 bridge across Violet Brook Stream, in Cyr Planta-
- 7 tion, in Aroostook County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Cyr Plantation had a population in 1880 of only five hundred and fifty-eight and a valuation of only about twenty-eight thousand dollars; they have several bridges in the plantation, two of which it will be necessary to rebuild the present season.

The cost of building these bridges will be about six hundred dollars, and in their financial condition such a sum added to their present taxes would be a grievous burden for the inhabitants of said plantation.
