STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Lucy Turner of Hebron.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the Treasury

- 2 of the State to Lucy Turner, of Hebron, the sum
- 3 of four dollars per month, as a military pension,
- 4 during the pleasure of the Legislature, commenc-
- 5 ing on the first day of January eighteen hundred
- 6 and eighty-seven.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Lucy Turner the widow of H. G. Turner late of Hebron asks that the Military Pension of \$4 per month granted her late husband in March, 1864, and continued until his decease be continued to her.
