STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Alveretta Wilbur of Pembroke.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury

- 2 of the State, to Alveretta Wilbur, of Pembroke,
- 3 the sum of eight dollars per month, as a military
- 4 pension, during the pleasure of the Legislature,
- 5 commencing January first, eighteen hundred and
- 6 eighty-seven.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mrs. Alveretta Wilbur of Pembroke, widow of Oren S. Wilbur, late private, Company "K," 31st Infantry, Maine Vols., who was a United States pensioner for wounds received in line of duty, and who was drowned August 4, 1885, leaving his wife and six children in destitute circumstances.
