STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT. An additional section to chapter thirty of
Revised Statutes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

A bounty of ten cents for every woodchuck killed
2 in any town shall be paid by the treasurer thereof
3 to the person depositing the tail of the same with
4 such treasurer, the treasurer to destroy such tail
5 by fire and take a receipt for all money thus paid
6 out, towns to be reimbursed as made and provided
7 in section seven of the above chapter in similar
8 cases.
