IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes, relating to Malicious Mischiefs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred and twenty-

- 2 seven of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after the word "any" and before the
- 4 word "domestic," in the second line, the words
- 5 'dog or' and inserting after the word "animal" in
- 6 the third line, the words 'or dog,' so that said sec-
- 7 tion as amended shall read as follows:
 - 'SECT. 1. Whoever wilfully or maliciously kills,
- 9 wounds, maims, disfigures or poisons any dog or

- 10 domestic animal or exposes any poisonous sub-
- 11 stance with intent that the life of such animal or
- 12 dog should be destroyed thereby, shall be punished
- 13 by imprisonment for not more than four years or
- 14 by fine not exceeding five hundred dollars.'
