STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to chapter five hundred and eleven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five, incorporating the Bingham and Moose River Telephone and Telegraph Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Bingham and Moose River
2 Telephone and Telegraph Company, incorporated
3 by the Legislature of eighteen hundred and eighty-
4 five, is hereby authorized to locate, construct and
5 operate its lines of telephone and telegraph from
6 some point in the town of Bingham, southerly

7 through the towns of Solon, Embden, Anson,
8 Madison and Norridgewock, to some point in the
9 town of Skowhegan, on the same terms and con-
10 ditions as are specified in the Act to which this is
11 additional.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
