STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Norway Electric Light
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Hermon L. Horne, William H. Whit-
2 comb, Silas D. Andrews, Henry M. Bearce, Geo.
3 L. Beal and Cyrus S. Tucker, with their associ-
4 ates, successors and assigns, are hereby made a body
5 corporate by the name of Norway Electric Light
6 Company, and as such shall possess all the powers
7 and be subject to all the duties and obligations

8 conferred and imposed on corporations by law, ex-
9 cept as otherwise provided herein.

SECT. 2. The corporation shall be located at
2 Norway, county of Oxford, Maine, and its business
3 shall be confined to the towns of Norway and
4 Paris in said county.

SECT. 3. The business to be carried on by said
2 corporation shall be to light the public streets in
3 Norway and Paris, and to dispose of electric light
4 and power to individuals and corporations, and for
5 this purpose may set poles and extend wires in the
6 streets of said towns, under the supervision of the
7 selectmen of said towns.

SECT. 4. The towns of Norway and Paris, and
2 the Norway Village Corporation and South Paris
3 Village Corporation, by their assessors, are hereby
4 authorized to contract with said Norway Electric
5 Light Company for lighting streets upon such
6 terms as they may mutually agree.

SECT. 5. The capital stock of said corporation
2 shall be twelve thousand dollars, divided into shares
3 of one hundred dollars each, and may be increased
4 to twenty thousand by a vote of the stock holders.

SECT. 6. The first meeting shall be called by any
2 two of the corporators, by giving a written notice
3 by them signed, of the time and place to each of

4 the other corporators twenty-four hours before the
5 time of meeting, at which first meeting such offi-
6 cers shall be elected as the corporation may vote
7 to have and officers shall be elected annually there-
8 after, and the corporation may adopt such by-laws
9 as are not repugnant to the laws of the State.

SECT. 7. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
