### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Bancroft Plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand (\$1,000)

- 2 dollars be and hereby is appropriated to aid in re-
- 3 pairing and building piers for the bridge over Mat-
- 4 tawamkeag River in Bancroft Plantation, Aroos-
- 5 took County, to be expended under the direction of
- 6 County Commissioners of Aroostook County.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The bridge over the Mattawamkeag River in Bancroft Plantation is a wooden, covered bridge built about 1850. The span is one hundred and twenty-five feet, the abutments were built eighteen feet high and were rebuilt in 1874 with hemlock logs, which are now getting so rotten that they must be rebuilt in order to save said bridge, which has been well cared for and is now in very good condition, otherwise than the abutments. The valuation of Bancroft Plantation in 1880 was polls, 58, estates, \$48,900. The estimated cost of stone abutments is \$2000. The State has heretofore assumed one-half of the expense of building and repairing said bridge.
