- 4 Orphan Asylum, of which there shall be paid seven
- 5 thousand dollars for current expenses in the year
- 6 eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, and seven
- 7 thousand dollars for current expenses in the year
- 8 eighteen hundred and eighty-eight.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It is understood that this Institution cannot be maintained without the continued aid from the State.
