STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Bath Military and Naval
Orphan Asylum.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of fourteen thousand (\$14,000) dollars for the use of the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum, of which there shall be paid seven thousand dollars for current expenses in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, and seven thousand dollars for current expenses in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Trustees in their annual report recommend the sum asked for in the resolve.

It is understood that this Institution cannot be maintained without the continued aid from the State.
