STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation for repair of roads
in Indian Township, Washington County.

Resolved, That the sum of twelve hundred dol-
2 lars be, and is hereby appropriated for the year
3 eighteen hundred eighty-seven, and eight hundred
4 dollars for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
5 eight, to be expended under the direction of the
6 County Commissioners upon the Houlton and Bar-
7 ing road and the road leading from said Houlton
8 and Baring road to Grand Lake Stream in Indian
9 Township, Washington County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation is asked for the purpose of keeping in repair the Houlton and Baring road, and the road leading from said Houlton and Baring road to Grand Lake Stream in Indian Township, Washington County, being twelve miles in length and a State road.

The road is in very bad condition, from the fact that heavy teams pass over the road daily, to and from the tanneries located at Grand Lake Stream, Brookton and Forest City, to connect with the railroad at Princeton. From fifteen to twenty four-horse teams pass over the road daily, besides the general travel.
