STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Eugene Michaud.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the State

- 2 treasury, to Eugene Michaud, the sum of seventy-
- 3 three dollars, being for money paid by him July
- 4 eleven, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, for lot of
- 5 land numbered forty-four in township numbered
- 6 seventeen, range seven, Aroostook County, said lot
- 7 having been awarded to said Michaud under the
- 8 treaty of Washington and paid for by the United
- 9 States.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the year 1849, Eugene Michaud paid the State for lot of land forty-four in cash, and the same lot was awarded to him, said Michaud, under the treaty of Washington and the State received from the United States the cash for the same lot at the rate of \$1.25 per acre. Michaud paid the money to the State at fifty cents per acre, July 11, 1849.
