STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty of Revised Statutes asking for a bounty on Crows.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. A bounty of ten cents for every 2 crow killed in any town shall be paid by the treas-3 urer thereof to the person depositing the head of 4 the same with such treasurer, the treasurer to de-5 stroy such head by fire and take a receipt for all 6 money thus paid out, towns to be reimbursed as 7 made and provided in section seven of the above 8 chapter in similar cases. •_____
