
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT making a copy of a Town Clerk's Record admissible as evidence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The record of a town clerk relative to a 2 birth, marriage or death occurring in his town, 3 shall be *prima facie* evidence in all legal 4 proceedings, of the facts so recorded; and a copy 5 of such record, attested by the town clerk of the 6 town for the time being, shall be admissible as evi-7 dence of such record.
