STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter forty-four, relating to Peddlers' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That section two of chapter forty-four of the Re-

- 2 vised Statutes of eighteen hundred eighty-three is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out all of said section
- 4 following the word "free," in the eighth line thereof,
- 5 so that said section as amended shall read as fol-
- 6 lows:
 - 'SECT. 2. The county commissioners may license
- 8 for the purposes aforesaid, any person who satisfies
- 9 them that he sustains a good moral character, and
- 10 has been for five years a citizen of the United

- 11 States; such licenses expire in one year from their
- 12 date and are not transferable; and the license, shall
- 13 pay therefor if he is to offer to sell by retail, ten
- 14 dollars, if by wholesale, twenty-five dollars; but
- 15 soldiers of the State disabled in the recent war of
- 16 the rebellion shall have their licenses free.'
