STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section nine, chapter three hundred sixty-six of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-five, relating to Intoxicating Liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section nine, chapter three hundred
2 sixty-six of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred
3 eighty-five is hereby amended by striking out the
4 word "all" in the fourth line of said section and
5 inserting the word 'each,' and by changing the
6 word "cases" in said line to 'case,' and by chang-
7 ing the word "indictments" to 'indictment,' so
8 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

‘SECT. 9. It shall be the duty of the clerk of
10 courts within thirty days after the adjournment of
11 any superior or supreme judicial court, to publish
12 in some newspaper of the county, the disposition
13 of each appealed case and indictment for violation
14 of the laws regulating the use and sale of intoxi-
15 cating liquors.
