STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale or gift of Cigarettes or
Cigars to Minors under fifteen years of age.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall sell any cigarettes or
2 cigars to any minor under fifteen years of age.

SECT. 2. No person, other than the minor's
2 parent or guardian, shall give any cigarettes or
3 cigars to any minor under fifteen years of age.

SECT. 3. Any person violating any of the pro-
2 visions of this act shall be punished by a fine not
3 exceeding fifty dollars for each and every offence.
