STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale or gift of Cigarettes or Cigars to Minors under fifteen years of age.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. No person shall sell any cigarettes or
- 2 cigars to any minor under fifteen years of age.
 - SECT. 2. No person, other than the minor's
- 2 parent or guardian, shall give any cigarettes or
- 3 cigars to any minor under fifteen years of age.
 - SECT. 3. Any person violating any of the pro-
- 2 visions of this act shall be punished by a fine not
- 3 exceeding fifty dollars for each and every offence.
