STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section forty-three of chapter seventy, of the revised statutes, relating to Insolvent Debtors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. When, for any cause, the debtor
- 2 shall fail to take and subscribe the oath referred to
- 3 in the forty-third section of chapter seventy of the
- 4 revised statutes, he may do so at any time within
- 5 one year from the date of commencement of pro-
- 6 ceedings, with the same effect as if originally taken.
- SECT. 2. This act shall apply to all cases now 2 pending.
- SECT. 3. This act shall take effect-when ap-2 proved.
