## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND BIGHT HUNDRED AND BIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend sections seventeen and twentyfour of chapter one hundred and eighteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Punishment for Rape.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section seventeen of chapter one hundred and

- 2 eighteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out the word "ten" in the first and third
- 4 lines thereof, and inserting in place thereof the word
- 5 'fourteen' so that said section as amended shall
- 6 read as follows:
  - 'SECT. 17. Whoever ravishes, and carnally
- 8 knows, any female of fourteen or more years of

9 age by force and against her will, or unlawfully 10 and carnally knows and abuses a female child 11 under fourteen years of age, shall be punished by

12 imprisonment for life, or for any term of years.

Section twenty-four of chapter one hundred and 2 eighteen is hereby amended by striking out the 3 word "ten" in the first and fourth lines thereof, 4 and inserting in place thereof the word 'fourteen,' 5 so that said section as amended shall read as fol-

'SECT. 24. Whoever assaults a female of four-8 teen years of age or more, with intent to commit a 9 rape, shall be punished by imprisonment not ex-10 ceeding ten years, or by fine not exceeding five 11 hundred dollars. If such assault is made on a 12 female under fourteen years, such imprisonment 13 shall not be for less than one year, nor more than 14 twenty years.
