IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to Compensation of County Commissioners of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. On and after January first, A. D.

- 2 eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, each County
- 3 Commissioner of Hancock County shall receive two
- 4 dollars and fifty cents a day while actually employed
- 5 in the service of the county, including the time
- 6 spent in travelling, for which every commissioner
- 7 shall have ten cents a mile for the distance act-
- 8 ually travelled; but no commissioner shall have
- 9 more than one travel during the same hearing or
- 10 session, or for more than two adjournments of any

- 11 regular term; nor for service or travel on more than
- 12 one petition or case at the same time; nor anything
- 13 for travel or attendance at the Legislature connected
- 14 with the annual county estimates; nor for any ad-
- 15 ditional trouble or expense.
 - SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent 2 with this act are hereby repealed.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
