STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Charles W. Davis.

Resolved, that there be paid to Charles W. Davis 2 of Lewiston, Guardian of Edwin A. Davis, a pen-3 sion of four dollars a month, commencing on the 4 first day of January, in the year of our Lord one 5 thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven.

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STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Edwin A. Davis of Lewiston, son of Charles T. Davis, deceased, late Co. "I," 29th Maine Inf'y Vols., when $2\frac{1}{2}$ years of age, had a fit of sickness which resulted in paralyzation of the tongue, and general nervous prostration. He has never been able to talk, and is so nervous that the people with whom he is boarded do not dare cross him in anything. He is, and has been considered in the light of a minor; never voted, and was never called upon to pay taxes. Has to be looked after and cared for same as a child. Charles W. Davis, a brother, has been appointed his guardian, and has given bonds as required by law. Said Edwin A. Davis is now about 40 years of age.
