STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to enable the Cumberland and Oxford Canal Corporation, its mortgagees or assigns, to dispose of a certain portion of the property of the corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Cumberland and Oxford Canal 2 Corporation, and its mortgagees or their assigns, 3 are authorized to sell, and to convey in any man-4 ner or to lease any or all of that part of its prop-5 erty situated and being between Sebago Lake 6 Basin, in the town of Standish, and the Portland 7 and Rochester Railroad location in the town of

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8 Westbrook, to any railroad corporation duly char-9 tered or organized under the laws of this State, to 10 be used for railroad purposes only, and any diver-11 sion of any part or all of said property to railroad 12 uses shall not affect the legality of such lease or 13 conveyance; *provided*, however, that said lease or 14 conveyance shall not embrace a greater width of 15 land than six rods measured three rods each way 16 from the middle of the canal ditch; and provided 17 further, that such railroad shall be constructed 18 within five years hereafter, and that this act shall 19 not apply to any portion of said canal or its right 20 of way fifteen hundred feet in length adjacent to 21 any dam or water power on the Presumpscot River, 22 and that for all said distances of fifteen hundred 23 feet said canal and all its rights of way are annulled, 24 except as may be otherwise from time to time agreed 25 in writing with the proprietors of any of said dams Said distances of 26 or water powers respectively. 27 fifteen hundred feet unless otherwise agreed in 28 writing with any of said proprietors shall be meas-29 ured one hundred feet up stream from each of said 30 dams or water powers respectively, and thence con-31 tinuing down stream till said fifteen hundred feet 32 is made out. And provided further, that this act 33 shall not apply to any portion of said canal or its

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34 rights of way upon or over land now owned by the
35 Oriental Powder Mills, and that said canal and all
36 rights of said Cumberland and Oxford Canal Cor37 poration, its mortgagees or assigns, upon said land
38 are hereby annulled.

SECT. 2. All franchises and other rights hereto-2 fore vested in said canal corporation, its mortgagees 3 or assigns, are hereby revived so far only as neces-4 sary to give full effect to the purposes of this act.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved. .
