1N THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to County Roads in Unincorporated Townships.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

County commissioners, when county roads in un-

- 2 incorporated townships and tracts of lands in their
- 3 counties are blocked or encumbered with snow,
- 4 shall forthwith cause so much of it to be removed
- 5 or trodden down as will render them passable; and
- 6 may appoint an agent or agents, not members of
- 7 their own board, to superintend the expenditure
- 8 therefor, who shall give bond as provided in section
- 9 seventy-eight, chapter six of the Revised Statutes,

10 if required; the whole expense whereof shall be 11 added to their next assessment on said lands author12 ized by section eighty of said chapter six of the 13 Revised Statutes, which assessment shall create a 14 lien upon said lands for the whole amount thereof 15 as effectually as is now provided in relation to 16 repairs on such county roads. That portion of said 17 assessment which is for expense incurred in remov18 ing or treading down snow as above required, shall 19 be set down, in distinct items, in a separate column, 20 and shall not be discharged under section eighty21 one of said chapter, but shall be enforced as is pro22 vided in section eighty-two of the said sixth chap23 ter of the Revised Statutes.
