STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT amendatory of and additional to chapter eighty-
one of the Revised Statutes, relating to Exemption of Per-
sonal Property from attachment and sale on execution.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Paragraph one of section 62 of chapter 81
2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking
3 out the word " fifty " in the second line, and inserting in-
4 stead thereof the words ' one hundred, ' so that said para-
5 graph of said section as amended shall read as follows :

' SECT. 62. I. The debtor's apparel, household furniture
7 necessary for himself, wife and children not exceeding one
8 hundred dollars in value, and one bed, bedstead and nec-
9 cessary bedding for every two such persons.'

SECT. 2. Paragraph six of section 62 of chapter 81
2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting

3 after word "occupation" in the first line, the words
4 'materials and stock designed and procured by him, and
5 necessary for carrying on his trade or business and in-
6 tended to be used or wrought therein not exceeding fifty
7 dollars in value,' so that said paragraph of said section as
8 amended shall read as follows :

9 'SECT. 62. VI. The tools necessary for his trade or
10 occupation, materials and stock designed and procured by
11 him and necessary for carrying on his trade or business
12 and intended to be used or wrought therein not exceeding
13 fifty dollars in value and one sewing machine not exceed-
14 ing one hundred dollars for actual use by himself or
15 family.'

SECT. 3. Paragraph nine of section 62 of chapter 81 of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the word "wagon" in the first line, the words 'or one
4 express wagon,' so that said section as amended shall read
5 as follows :

6 'SECT. 62. IX. One plough, one cart or truck wagon,
7 or one express wagon, one harrow, one yoke with bows,
8 ring and staple, two chains, one ox sled and one mowing
9 machine.'

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
