STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for reduction of the State Valuation of Eastport.

Resolved, That the State valuation of the estates

- 2 in the town of Eastport for the purposes of State
- 3 taxation, is hereby fixed at \$638,892.00 instead of
- 4 \$888,892.00, until otherwise ordered by the Legis-
- 5 lature or a new general valuation shall be taken.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Town of Eastport was visited by a most serious conflagration October 14th, 1886, which destroyed a very large amount of taxable property, to such an extent that it will require several years of prosperity to recover the amount of her lost valuation.
