STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the Revised Statutes, relating
“to Salaries of Public Officers and Compensation to
Members of the Government.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section eight of chapter one hundred and fifteen
2 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the word “one” in the eleventh line
4 thereof, and inserting in place thereof the word
5 ‘two,’ so that the first twelve lines of said section
6 as amended shall read as follows: (no change in
7 the remainder.)

'SECT. 8. Each member of the Executive Council shall receive the same compensation and travel as a Representative to the Legislature, for services as a Councillor during the session of the Council, commencing in January and closing immediately after the adjournment of the Legislature. For services at other sessions of the Council, each Councillor shall be paid two dollars for every day's actual attendance, and two dollars for every mile travel, one way, from his place of abode to the Capitol; and for authorized services on committees, when the Council is not in session. Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall receive two hundred and fifty dollars for the regular session of the Legislature, and two dollars for every ten miles' travel from his place of abode, once in each session.'
