IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-one of chapter forty of the Revised Statutes, relating to Fish-Ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 31 of chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by striking out of said section
- 3 the following words: "Duck Trap Stream in
- 4 Lincolnville and Belmont," so that said section, as
- 5 amended, shall read as follows:
 - 'Section 31. The following waters and their tribu-
- 7 taries are exempt from provisions relating to migra-
- 8 tory fishes, and the supervision of fish-ways by the

- 9 commissioners, that is to say: Royall's River in
- 10 North Yarmouth; Sewall's Pond or its outlet in
- 11 Arrowsic; Neguassett Stream in Woolwich; so
- 12 much of the waters of the Damariscotta River as
- 13 are west of the railroad bridge near Damariscotta
- 14 Mills; the eastern Penobscot River in Orland;
- 15 Winslow's and Leach's streams in Penobscot; all
- 16 waters in Vinalhaven, Bluehill, Tremont, Mount
- 17 Desert, Eden, Franklin and Sullivan; Tunk River
- 18 in Steuben; Pleasant River in Washington County;
- 19 East Machias River and Cobscook or Orange
- 20 River in Whiting.'
