Resolved, That the sum of nineteen thousand, nine

- 10 For repairs in boys' dining-room, five hundred dol-
- 11 lars.
- 12 For general repairs, two thousand dollars.
- 13 For current expenses, fifteen thousand dollars.
- 14 For the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight,
- 15 For general repairs, two thousand dollars.
- 16 For current expenses, fifteen thousand dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The following statement of facts in relation to Resolve entitled "in favor of State Reform School" is respectfully submitted.

The sum of fifteen thousand dollars for current expenses, and two thousand dollars for general repairs has been the usual amount appropriated.

The purchase of the Coleman Farm is a necessity and will add very much to the farming interest and profit which will be realized.

The repairs in boys' dining-room is an actual necessity, the floor and ceiling being in a condition which deserves attention as soon as practicable.
